Instructions: Wrapping Up 2025 classes

We have added a [message to yourjuniper.org](#) explaining the pause in class availability with Juniper as we transition to our new software in 2026. This message is meant to help interested participants and referrers understand why class volume is down, and encourage people to sign up for our waitlist to be notified once classes are available again.

All classes, except in-progress DPP classes, should have all data entered and be marked “complete” by 1/15/2026.

If you want to launch classes before the new Juniper software is ready, you can do so. If you are launching a class that is covered by a Trellis-managed license (Stepping On, Matter of Balance or Tai Ji Quan: Moving for Better Balance), please follow the reporting procedure below. Any classes launched before the new Juniper software is ready will not be eligible for Juniper grant or health plan contract reimbursement.

Instructions: Interim Class Reporting for Licensure

Trellis manages on behalf of the Juniper network our licenses to offer A Matter of Balance (MOB), Stepping On (SO) and Tai Ji Quan: Moving for Better Balance (TJQMBB). These licenses are required in order to offer these programs, and each license has unique reporting requirements.

While we are temporarily without a Juniper website, you are not expected to report detailed participant information. We do need some information from you for license coverage and reporting.

Please fill out the form linked below for any MOB, SO and TJQMBB classes offered between now and when the new Juniper website is ready.

Classes should be reported once they are finished. Data you will need to report includes:

- Name of Class
- Start Date
- End Date
- First and Last Names of Class Leader(s)
- Class Modality (in-person vs online)
- Total number of participants
- Total number of completers

This is not applicable for Diabetes Prevention Program, Powerful Tools for Caregivers, SAIL, Walk with Ease or Arthritis Foundation Exercise Program classes. This is also not applicable for any leader training.

Not completing this report impacts the data we share with our licensing entities and may result in a class leader losing their certification.

Software Transition FAQ

Q: Will the HIPAA training still be available during the first quarter of 2026?

A: The HIPAA training, and Juniper Provider Toolkit site, will remain available until our new website is ready. Once our new website is ready, we will be transitioning our toolkit onto the new site.

Q: When will the current yourjuniper.org site be shut down?

A: The current yourjuniper.org site will be available until 1/15/2026 (10 business days into 2026) to allow time for classes ending in December to enter their data and be marked complete.

Q: When will the new website be ready?

A: We anticipate that the new website will be ready in March 2026.

Q: Will training be provided on the new website?

A: Yes, training will be provided to provider contacts and class leaders on using the new website before it goes live to the public and participants. Training will occur in late February or March, depending on the readiness of the new site.

Q: Can we offer classes independently in 2026 before the new website is ready?

A: Yes, you can offer classes independently in 2026 before the new website is ready. Those classes will not be eligible for Juniper reimbursement. For Matter of Balance, Stepping On, and Tai Ji Quan: Moving for Better Balance classes, please use the [Interim Class Reporting for Licensure – Fill out form](#) to ensure license coverage during the website pause.
